

**Glossy Ibis** (*Plegadis falcinellus*).

Singles over Worth Marshes on May 4<sup>th</sup> and on Nov 17<sup>th</sup> 1979 were presumably those resident at Stodmarsh at the time. During an unprecedented influx into UK in Sept 2009, three dropped into New Downs New Pool on the evening of Sept 21<sup>st</sup> and singles were seen over Pegwell on Oct 8<sup>th</sup> and S over the Observatory on Oct 11<sup>th</sup>. A colour-ringed first-winter individual appeared on Restharrow Scrape on Dec.29<sup>th</sup> 2013 and two were present there from Jan 16<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> 2014.
