

**Leach's Petrel** (*Oceanodroma leucorhoa*). One was found stranded on the road at the Bay during severe gales on Nov 30<sup>th</sup> 1952. Singles were seen on Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1977 and Oct 12<sup>th</sup> 1980 when several others were seen off North Kent and in 1986 a bird picked up from a ferry between Zeebrugge and Dover was ringed and released on Sept 8<sup>th</sup>. There were singles S on Oct 10<sup>th</sup> 1987, over the Estate on Oct 15<sup>th</sup> 1988 and S on Dec 27<sup>th</sup> 1989. In 2000, one flew N at Pegwell on Oct 6<sup>th</sup>. After a gap of eight years one flew N offshore on Nov 5<sup>th</sup> 2008; the 8<sup>th</sup> record for the recording area.
