

Temminck's Stint (*Calidris temminckii*).

At least 60 individuals of this scarce passage wader have been recorded since the first at Backsand Point on Sep 2nd 1955 to the most recent in 2013. All records since are from Pegwell, the Sampher and more recently from the two scrapes. Most spring records are in May, ranging from Apr 7th (1974) to June 8th (2005). In autumn most are in August, ranging from July 20th (1975) to Sep 30th (1967) although there is an exceptionally late record of one on Oct 21st 1963. Most records are of singles, though five in Pegwell on May 11th 1980 was (and may still be) a Kent record.
